The Memorial Garden



In 1988, First Congregational UCC established a Memorial Garden below the Chapel to provide a peaceful outdoor setting where cremains may be scattered.

The Memorial Garden is meant as a setting for contemplation, meditation and affirming our faith in eternal life. Plantings and flowers have been carefully selected to maintain an atmosphere of peace and beauty throughout the changing seasons.

The names and dates of those whose ashes rest in the garden are recorded on a permanent plaque outside the Chapel. No markers, permanent containers, or urns are used in the garden itself. We recommend that ashes be scattered in the Memorial Garden areas only.

One of our pastors is available to help plan and officiate for a service of committal.
