HWA WAIVER, HOLD HARMLESS, AND GEAR RENTAL AGREEMENT

In consideration of permission granted by Hatch Wilderness Adventures LLC (HWA) allowing me to rent gear for wilderness travel and use the provided gear, I (together with my parent or guardian, if I am under the age of eighteen (18) or under a legal disability) represent, covenant and agree, on behalf of myself and my heirs, assigns, and any other person claiming by, under or through me, as follows:

1. I acknowledge that participating in wilderness travel involves certain risks (some of which I may not fully appreciate) and that injuries, death, hypothermia, property damage or other harm could occur to me or others. I accept and voluntarily incur all risks of any injuries, damages, or harm which arise during or result from my participation in the wilderness activity I am participating in, including any associated travel, regardless of whether or not caused in whole or in part by the negligence or other fault of Hatch Wilderness Adventures.
2. I waive all claims against HWA for any injuries, damages, losses or claims, whether known and unknown, which arise during or result from my participation in wilderness travel, regardless of whether or not caused in whole or part by the negligence or other fault of any of the Released Parties. I release and forever discharge Hatch Wilderness Adventures from all such claims.
3. I agree to indemnify and hold HWA harmless from all losses, liabilities, damages, costs or expenses (including but not limited to reasonable attorneys' fees and other litigation costs and expenses) incurred by any of the Released Parties as a result of any claims or suits that I (or anyone claiming by, under or through me) may bring against any of the Released Parties to recover any losses, liabilities, costs, damages, or expenses which arise during or result from my participation in the Activity, regardless of whether or not caused in whole or part by the negligence or other fault of any of the Released Parties.
4. I understand that I am being rented personal and group gear for which I am liable. If I fail to return my personal rented gear, or if the returned gear must be replaced due to damage beyond normal wear and tear, I will fully compensate HWA for the gear. I agree to the replacement value HWA will provide and will reimburse HWA within one business week.
5. I have carefully read and reviewed this Waiver, Release, Gear Rental, And Hold Harmless Agreement. I understand it fully and I execute it voluntarily.

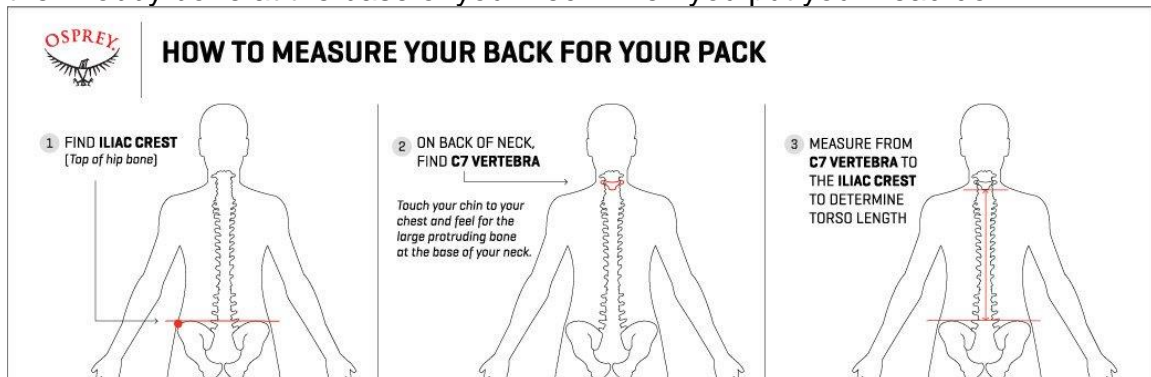
CANOE PADDLE TORSO SIZING

Sit up straight on a flat chair. Measure the distance from the surface of the chair to your nose. That distance is your torso length.



BACKPACK TORSO SIZING

Many Osprey packs are available in multiple sizes to fit a range of torso lengths. To determine your torso measurement, please see diagram below. This measurement starts at the iliac crest, which is the top of your hipbone on the side of your body that acts like a shelf. From this point, measure to the C7 vertebrae, the knobby bone at the base of your neck when you put your head down.



MARMOT RAINWEAR SIZING

Use this chart for both your jacket and pants: S-XXL only. Rainwear should fit fairly loose to accommodate layering. If you need a substantially smaller size than Men/Unisex offered, please use the “Alpha” (youth) size chart and indicate “Alpha” plus the size requested in your application. We will do everything possible to meet your request.
